
WANT TO TESTIFY?

All bill hearings will be held in-person with a virtual oral testimony option (via Zoom) and streamed live on YouTube.

Oral testimony sign up and **written** testimony (must be a PDF document) submission is done using **MyMGA** on the <u>Maryland General Assembly website</u> home page (see icon on the upper right corner of home page). MyMGA works best on Chrome or Microsoft Edge browsers; for Apple devices the Safari browser is best. Other browsers might kick you out of the system.




The following chart details sign up and written testimony submission timing:

Hearing is on a	Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday	Friday
You must sign up to testify and/or submit written testimony on	The previous Thursday from 8:00am-6:00pm	The previous Friday from 8:00am-6:00pm	The previous Monday from 8:00am-6:00pm	The previous Tuesday from 8:00am-6:00pm	The previous Wednesday from 8:00am-6:00pm
If a virtual witness, Zoom link emailed to you	Previous Friday	Monday	Tuesday	Wednesday	Thursday

Each witness will generally have a time limit of 2 minutes. However, if there are many witnesses, the time limit may be reduced to 1 minute.

When you are ready to submit written testimony follow these steps:


2. Sign into your 'MY MGA Account'



3. After signing in, click on witness signup.



Scroll down to the appropriate committee.



5. Click on box to the left of HB#, fill in organization box, fill in your position, click on written in the testimony box, upload PDF file to the right of testimony box, then hit the SAVE icon in the top left.

Please note you can follow this procedure if you would like to set up oral testimony, or just register a FAV or UNF for a specific bill.
